# EVERYDAY TOILET SEAT

CODE: 235770

## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



1. Brackets are always inserted from the inside facing outwards on both sides. Each side should reflect the other. You can choose how you want to place your bolts depending on the location of the holes in your pan, however both sides should remain symmetrical. (IE if your left bolt has the stem in the top left corner, then your right bolt should fit opposite with the stem in the top right corner).

2. The hinge has a hole through it. The bracket has a cylindrical piece to slide into this hole.

3. Slide the cylindrical part of the bracket into the hinges as shown. The brackets must be attached from the inside pointing out, however you can use either piece (depending on whether you want your seat to sit slightly forward or backward).

4. Slide the bolt into the bracket. This bolt can be fitted 4 ways to best suit the placement of the holes in your pan. Place the 2nd bolt in the other side as a mirror image. If the bolt placement is not symmetrical, the seat may sit unevenly on the pan.

5. With both bolts in place and symmetrical, try to fit the seat to the pan holes. The bolts can be slid side to side slightly to fit. If the bolts are too wide for the holes, remove them, and rotate to place the stem on the inner corner.

6. When seat has been placed into the pan, on the underside of your pan, add the washer (flat side up), then add the nut as shown (curved side up). Tighten nut to hold seat firmly.

## MAINTENANCE CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Clean with warm soapy water or a household detergent using a soft cloth or sponge. Do not use bleach or a harsh chemical based cleaner. Do not use a scourer as this may damage the finish.
